

Career Transition Assistance (CTA) courses:

- Are delivered over a maximum of eight weeks
- ► Require 75 hours of participation
- ▶ Include a combination of small group sessions and one-on-one support
- Are delivered face-to-face where practicable to encourage collaboration, networking and peer-to-peer support.

Overview

Career Transition Assistance assists you to gain the skills and knowledge to get back into the workforce. Our team of experts will assist you to identify your existing transferable skills, any skill gaps you might have and how to address these, while providing tailored career advice that suits your skill set and personal attributes.

Workshops are run face-to-face in small groups of 15 participants to ensure that you get personalised support, gain confidence in your job search skills and explore different technologies to find your next job. The Group Workshop Activities are specifically designed to foster empowerment, self-determination and provide opportunities to share ideas, thoughts and successes in a supportive peer-to-peer environment.

Additional Support - Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) Support

CTA participants will have the opportunity to undertake an online LLN assessment to determine their individual needs. LLN issues can impact a lot of people, and having trouble with these skills is nothing to be embarrassed about. At IntoJobs, we have a range of methods to assist people who struggle with LLN.
